

**Motion on Notice****MOTION TO SUSPEND AND REPLACE COUNCIL PROCEDURE RULE 19.2.1**

Given the significance of the decision and the weight of public opinion on the Calverley Square project, it is proposed to increase the amount of time allocated for public speakers on the relevant agenda item. An increase from the usual 12 minutes to 24 minutes would double the number of speakers from 4 to 8. Additionally, to ensure a balance of views being presented to the meeting, 4 spaces would be reserved for supporters and 4 spaces for objectors – similar to the arrangements for Planning Committee meetings. This would be achieved by passing the motion set out below.
