

Covid-19/Coronavirus precautions when attending meetings

The legislation that allowed us to conduct virtual meetings ended on 7 May 2021. There is currently no provision for the legislation to be extended so meetings will revert to physical meetings.

Covid-19 restrictions however still apply so the way we conduct meeting will be different to before.

Precautions

If attending a meeting at the town hall, please observe the following:

- Face masks (or a suitable alternative such as a face shield) must be worn anywhere in the Town Hall. They may only be removed once seated in the Council Chamber.
- Do not linger or congregate in the corridors.
- Please observe any specific instructions which may be in place on the day of the meeting.
- Please arrive in good time in advance of the meeting. Expect queues, it may take longer than normal to seat all members so allow more time than usual.
- You will be allocated a seat in the Council Chamber for a meeting, please do not change seats and please refrain from moving around the room.
- Hand sanitiser will be available.
- Access to bathrooms will be limited. Please observe any special arrangements which may be notified on the doors.
- After a meeting do not wait around in the Town Hall, please exit the building as quickly as possible.
