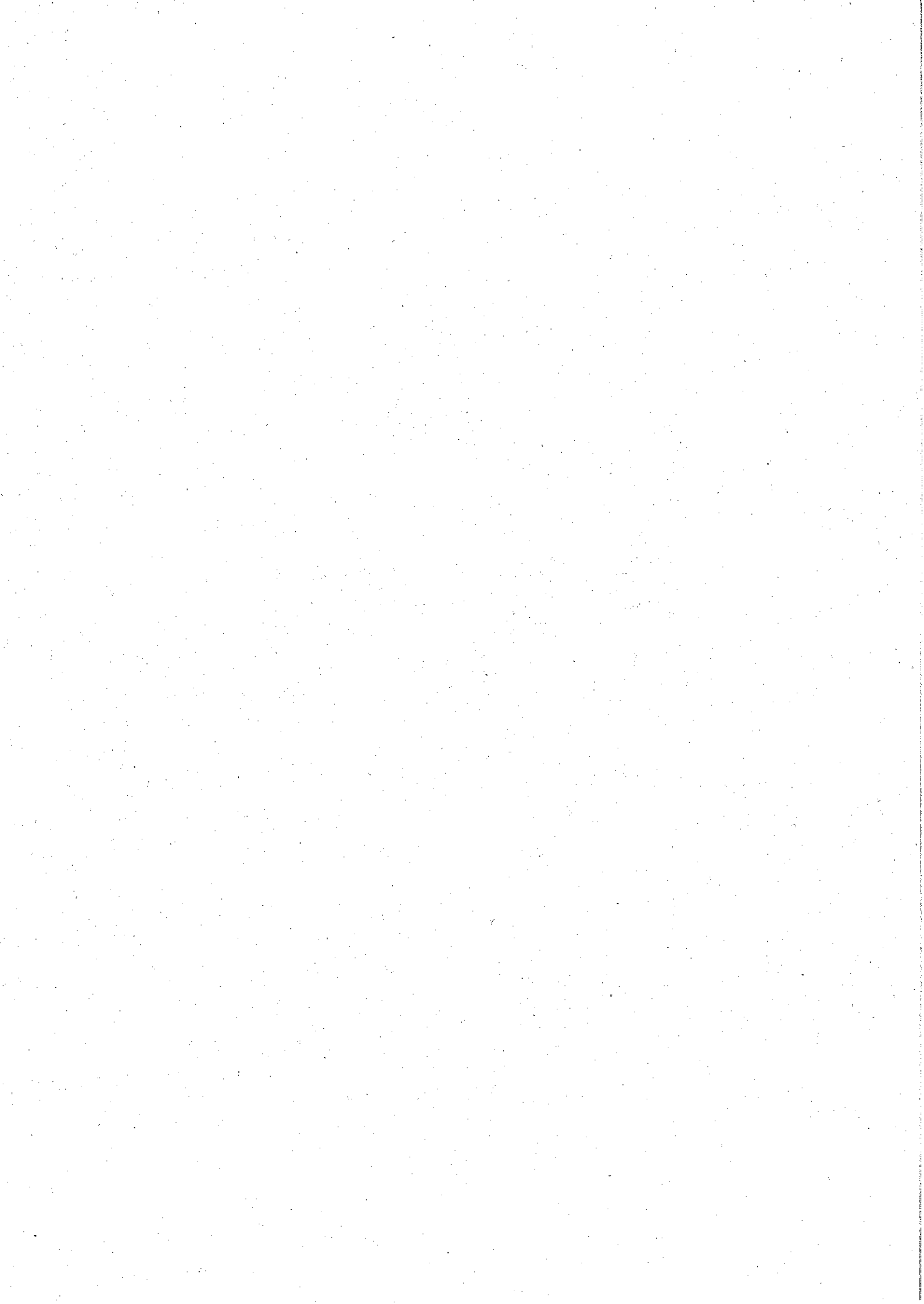

This is my personal statement for Mr. Nick Love with regards to representation in support of Premise Licence holder.

I have professional employ Mr. Love in the Role of Health & Safety Manager, as part of my team, in the capacity of my own role as the Head of Health & Safety at the All England Lawn Tennis Club (The Championships) Limited since 2015.

Mr. Love role supports the delivery of The Championships, with a contract typically running from March - August each year. This is technically demanding period and requires considerable competence, not just in just with health and safety but also licensing. Approximately 12 weeks of this is focused on the build, before moving into a 3 weeks event period (include the Qualification Week), across four venues, with over 500,000 people attending the Main Grounds for 13 days, with a typically event day of 13 hours, working splits, and demanding a comprehensive understand of numerous sectors. This Championships is also regarded as Britain largest outside broadcast event in the sporting calendar, as well as Europe's largest food event. Following the event, we move into a period of de-rig which can last 21-days, during which Mr. Love is pivotal in the venues transitions back to a private Members club, with a Museum and tours open to the public, and with major construction works reengage.

Aside from his high level of competency, Mr. Love has shown himself to be a hardworking, diligent, passionate, and personable. I am confident that he is a valuable asset on has other ventures, as he is a valuable asset to my own team at the All England.

His range of professional experience include countless festivals, and notably having worked on the BBC Safety Unit for show such as Top Gear, independently as a production safety advisor at Glastonbury Festival, as well as recently for The Walt Disney Corporation on a major feature films. I know Mr. Love to hold NEBOSH qualifications, as well as several Emergency Planning College qualifications and necessary industry tickets for Temporary Demountable Structures and other plant

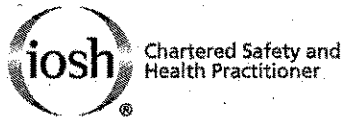
