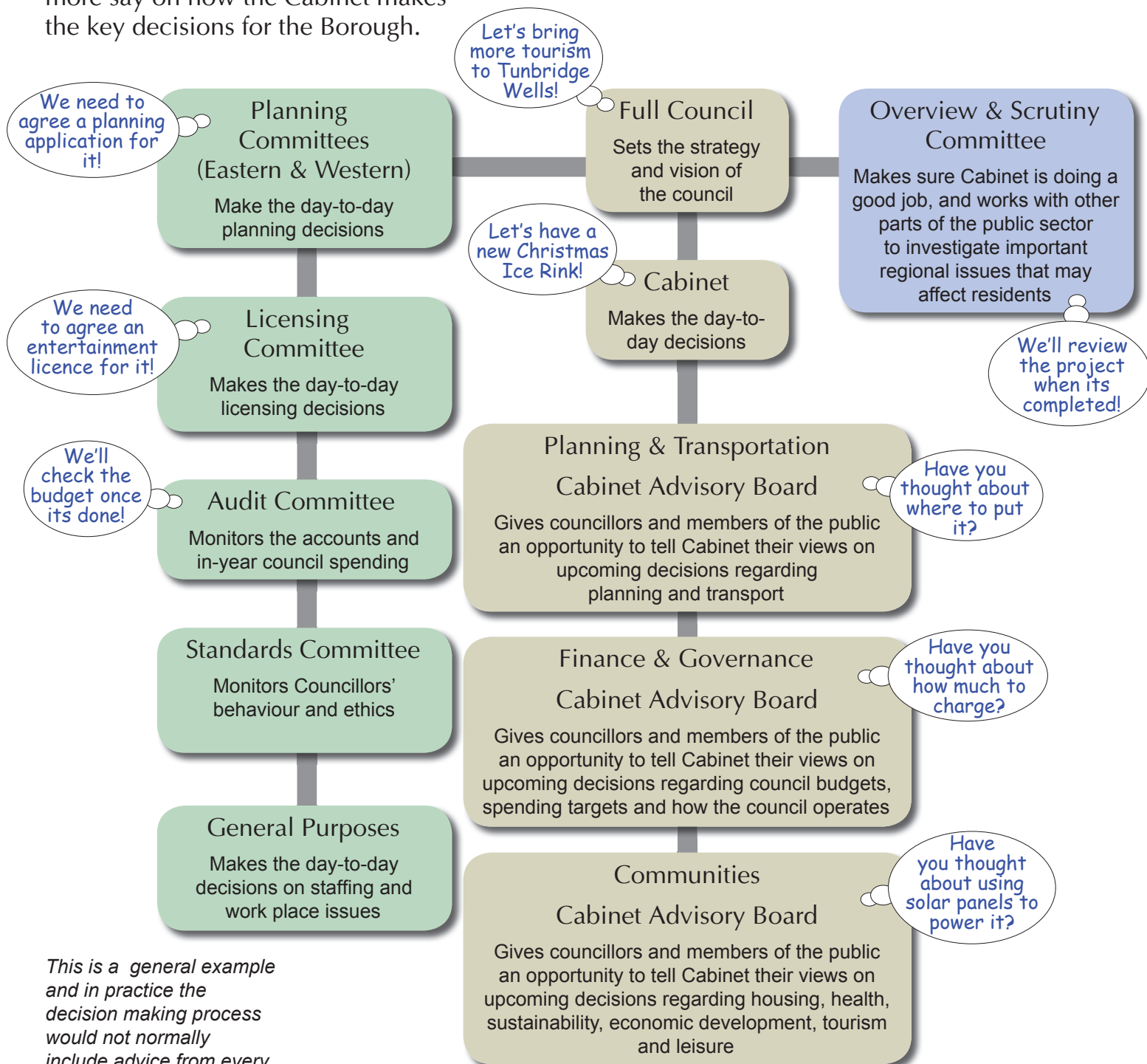


A new way to make decisions at TWBC

This new structure gives local ward members more say on how the Cabinet makes the key decisions for the Borough.

Three new Cabinet Advisory Boards will meet in public and will give back-bench members a chance to influence and give advice on the best approach before Cabinet makes the final decision. The Cabinet Advisory Boards will look at all decisions before Cabinet does and make recommendations or suggestions for improvement. The other side of the Council's decision making process, including planning and licensing, remains unchanged.



This is a general example and in practice the decision making process would not normally include advice from every council committee before the decision is made.
